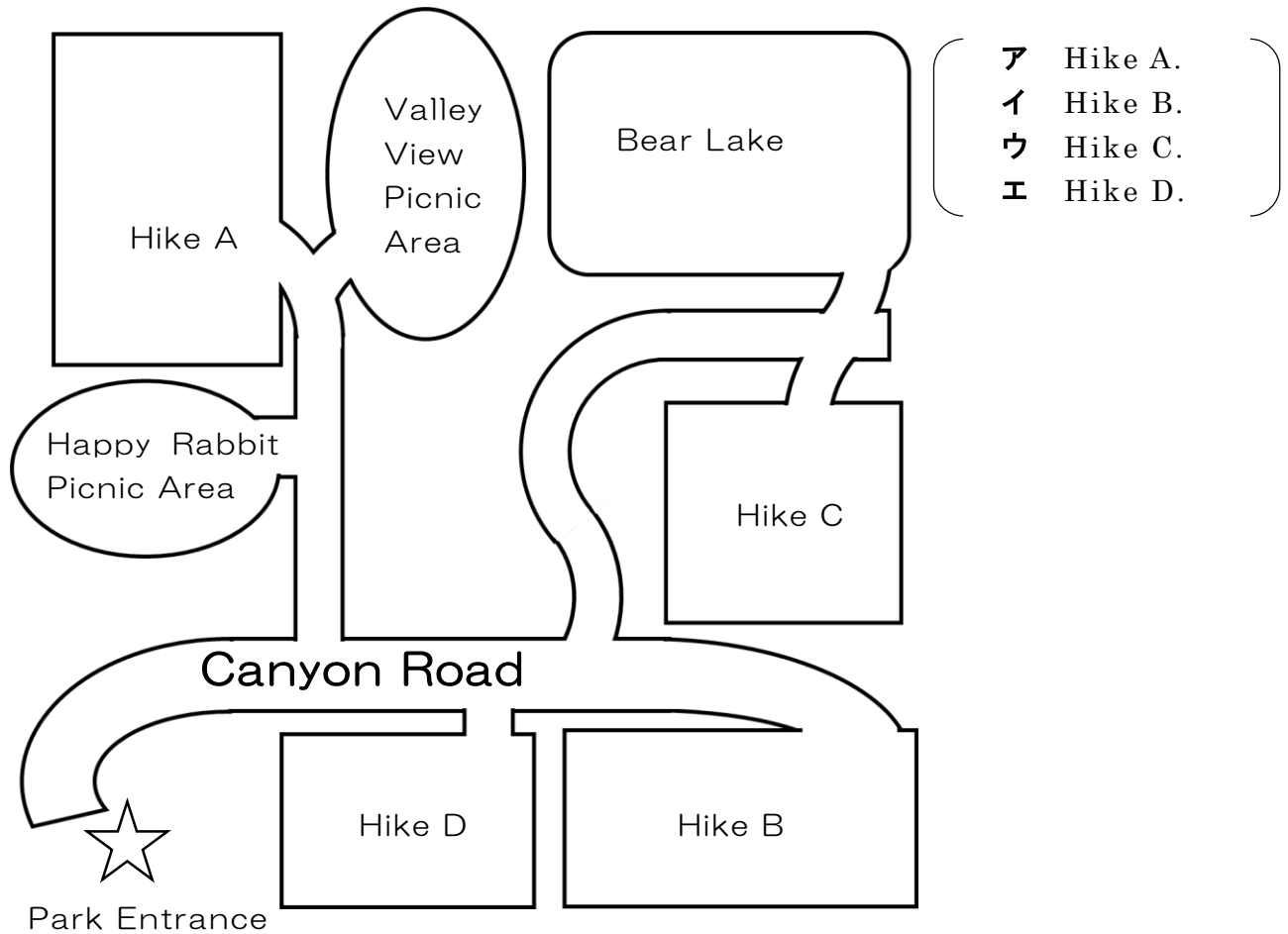

The child smiled and said “I’m fine”. After that, Junko made sure to keep Koro on a shorter leash and was more careful when walking him.

Aiko : Hey Brandon. Have you heard about the charity concerts and events happening for the *victims of the Ishikawa earthquake?

Brandon: I've heard a little bit, but I'm not really (①) what they're all about. I mean, I know these events *raise money, but do they really get a lot of people to come?

Aiko : Yes, they do. Charity events are very important. They bring people together and make a lot of money for rebuilding communities and supporting people who have lost their homes. Look at this webpage. There is a big event in August in Yokkaichi to help the people in Ishikawa. This will not just make money for the people in Ishikawa but also bring together the people in north Mie.

Brandon: I see. But are people going to give money just because of a concert? I think they are going for the music (②) than the earthquake victims.

Aiko : That's true. People do go for the music, but the sense of helping other people while doing something you enjoy makes it very special. The charity concerts at the Yokkaichi Culture Center have a wide variety of events that older and younger people can enjoy together. The money from ticket sales, selling goods and donations will go directly to organizations working in the *disaster area.

Brandon: I see from the website that some of the concerts are *streamed online too. So people from all over Japan can watch and give to the charity.

Aiko : Yes! People from Japan and all over the world can watch the concert and help. A lot of people outside Japan (③). This will help them better understand the bad situation there. Concerts and events like these have a very strong message of hope, not just about making money.

Brandon: You're right. Music makes people feel good. I also see that there will be events with traditional Japanese music and instruments.

Aiko : Yes. This is a great opportunity to promote traditional Japanese music and raise awareness of the importance of supporting local culture.
